RESOLUTION ADOPTING INTERIM ZONING ORDINANCE AND GIVING IMMEDIATE EFFECT

At a meeting of the Township Board for the Township of Ogden, Lenawee County, Michigan, held on the 25 day of February 2026, at 7 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Josh Van Camp and seconded by Brian Wilcox.

WHEREAS, Michigan Zoning Enabling Act (“MZEA”) 2006 PA 110, sets forth a procedure for adopting an interim zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 404 of the MZEA, the Township Board directed the Township’s Planning Commission to submit, within forty-five (45) days, recommendations as to the provisions of an interim zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met and discussed provisions and a draft interim zoning ordinance (the “Interim Zoning Ordinance”); and

WHEREAS, by resolution on December 3, 2025, the Planning Commission determined to recommend the Interim Zoning Ordinance to the Township Board, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2025, the Planning Commission submitted the Interim Zoning Ordinance to the Region 2 Lenawee County Planning Commission in accordance with the MZEA, who reviewed the Interim Zoning Ordinance at its meeting on December 18, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has now presented its recommendations and the Interim Zoning Ordinance to the Township Board; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has reviewed the Interim Zoning Ordinance and determines it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township to approve the Interim Zoning Ordinance, as recommended by the Planning Commission, and to give it immediate effect as permitted by MCL 125.3404.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township Board of the Township of Ogden resolves as follows:

1. The Interim Zoning Ordinance (attached hereto as Exhibit A), is hereby adopted and approved.
2. The Interim Zoning Ordinance is hereby given immediate effect and shall be filed with the Township Clerk.
3. The Clerk shall publish a notice of adoption of the Interim Zoning Ordinance (attached hereto as **Exhibit B**) within 15 days of adoption.
4. If any airport manager has registered its name and mailing address with the Township Clerk for the purpose of receiving notices, a copy of the notice of adoption shall be mailed to the airport manager(s).
5. Any resolution that conflicts with this Resolution is repealed, but only to the extent necessary to give this Resolution full force and effect.
